WORKING CRAFT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Festival Dates: Saturday, September 18 and Sunday, September 19, 2010

1 There is no set up fee or cost for working crafts. You are permitted to sell your crafts from your location and keep any monies obtained from the sell of your craft. This is our way of saying “thank you” for sharing your talents during our festival. Those doing working crafts are encouraged to offer a “hands on experience” for the festivalgoer. We are working on enlarging this area of the festival. Please keep in mind we are a family oriented festival.

2 Set up times are as follows: 10:00 am – 3:00 pm Friday, September 17; and 6:30 am to

8:00 am, Saturday and Sunday, September 18 and 19. Vehicles are to be unloaded and removed from the festival area ***no later than 8:30 am on Saturday and Sunday***. Vendors must be set up and ready to **start demonstrating by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday and ending around 5:00 p.m. days**. If you run out of product prior to the festival end, you will NOT be allowed to tear down until the close of the festival, 5:00pm Sunday. Grounds Security will be in place Friday evening starting at 8:00 p.m. and running non-stop through Sunday at 5:00pm.

3. No items except what is listed on your contract and approved by the Chairperson may displayed and/or demonstrated. No home canned goods will be allowed.

The appropriate Chairperson will designate space locations. This will be determined on a “first come, first placed” system.

1 You are responsible for furnishing our own power cords, which must be, which must be a minimum of 14-gauge and a maximum of 50 feet long. Water is available near all assigned spaces. Keep your own concession area clean and attractive. Please leave the area as you found it. Trash pick up is provided.

2 All personnel working your booth are asked to be dressed in period clothing. Women: long skirts or dresses or prairie jumpers. Men: Jeans and work (blue chambray) or plaid shirts. Rustic cooking such as open fires, iron kettles, etc., is welcome.

3 Camping spaces are available on the southwest corner and northeast corner of the grounds. All necessary hookups are there for your convenience. Cost per night is \$18.00.

1 All crafts listed on the following contract must be **HOMEMADE**.

2 No pets, other than service dogs, will be allowed in the festival area at any time.
